PRE-VISIT PREPARATION

STRUCTURE OF QUESTIONING: USING BLOOM'S TAXONOMY

Start with **what, where, when** questions to get the basic factual details. Try and ask questions which are beyond the obvious. In order to find out more interesting details ask How and Why questions These will help you to find out explanations and reasons.



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Think of questions that others may not have thought of.



Remember that a good investigator always asks more questions than they have on their plan!
