

Seascape Artists Required!

Can you make effective artistic choices?

Student Introduction

- ▶ This task will require you to provide an artistic response to your journey on the Red Funnel ferry, using different media.
- ▶ How creative can you get?



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1. Curriculum relevant materials supporting school trips to the Isle of Wight at East
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2. You could photograph in different ways you could:
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- » Have the landscape as a backdrop
- » Focus in on a specific ship, vessel or boat (or part of one)
- » Photograph a cluster of boats together.

TASK: AT SCHOOL

1. Choose your favourite photograph. You may want to focus on a section or use the whole photograph if you wish.
2. Use the internet to investigate different examples of seascape artwork which use different media (e.g. charcoal, pencil, pastels, textiles).
3. When you find an example which inspires you, you will use this media or style to re-create the image in your chosen photograph.
4. Once this is complete, have a look at some paintings of seascapes by Vincent Van Gogh.
