There are all sorts of ways that they do this - can you spot them?

As part of your journey, you are going to record all of the safety features which you notice.

### Your investigation needs to start as soon as you enter the port:

- » You may notice that the staff are wearing certain clothes
- » Look out for safety signs
- » You might notice how different passengers are treated in different ways
- » You might hear safety announcements before you board or once on the ship
- Once on board, you are then going to search the ship for anything which shows that Red Funnel is looking after the health and safety of its customers
- » Photograph any evidence and/or note down your observations, or key words you hear, on the table on page 2
- » Remember you will need to search above eye-level as things aren't always right in front of you!
