Education Destination clients may use East Dene facilities on a day basis if staying elsewhere, or we can build an accommodation plus activities package to suit your age group or learning objectives.

All activities are instructor led, and include favourites such as archery, bushcraft activities, team-building activities such as the blindfold trail and raft-buildings, plus traditional outdoor pursuits such as map reading and orienteering.
