Heritage Museum

Isle of Wight Steam Railway is a living, working museum with a Victorian / Edwardian era heritage steam railway which passes through 5.5 miles of unspoilt countryside.

The museum is located in the small village of Havenstreet, approximately a quarter of the way along the line which runs from Wootton through to Smallbrook Junction where there is an interchange with the Island's electric scheduled passenger service.

A Bygone Age

Arriving at the station in Havenstreet is like stepping back in time to a bygone age.

Smartly-dressed controllers and conductors control the flow of trains, whilst experienced tradesmen work on restoring and repairing engines and wagons in the workshops.

Visit the working signalbox where levers, bells and token rings are the norm.

Train Story

Train Story is a modern interactive exhibition space packed full of interpretative exhibits, and rolling stock not currently being used on the live railway for students to climb aboard and explore.
