WIldheart Animal Sanctuary

Still referred to by many as "Isle of Wight Zoo" or "Sandown Zoo", Wildheart Animal Sanctuary features an incredible range of creatures from pocket-sized primates to powerful predators.

These include tigers, lions, lynx, lemurs, monkeys, meerkats, reptiles and many more species, all living in a special home that is designed to allow rescued animals to flourish in a caring environment.

The caring staff hope to inspire people to take positive action to protect our planet and the animals we share it with.

Educational Visits

As well as casual self-led visits. Learning & Discovery sessions are available supported by qualified staff.

Typically these visits last half a day and includes a discussion session about one of the animals' stories how they came to be at the sanctuary, threats to their species in the wild, and what Wildheart are doing to promote the species as part of their conservation work around the world.

Learning & Discovery Centre

Booked groups can have use of the Learning & Discovery Centre which can be used for lunch, a bag drop, or any lesson / follow-up activities you want to undertake with your group before or after your visit.

Additional Facilities

The sanctuary has a large outdoor playground area and a cafe, as well as plenty of space for a picnic packed lunch.

The sanctuary is extremely accessible with no reliance on the use of steps, and large disabled toilet facilities.
