Stunning Gorge

The Isle of Wight's oldest tourist attraction, carved by mother nature's hands over thousands of years, the stunning tree-lined gorge that is Shanklin Chine cuts its mark from Shanklin Old Village down to the sandy beach and esplanade below.

There are few places that can boast such a tranquil and picturesque location.

Wildlife

A haven for wildlife, Shanklin Chine's steep sides and flowing water provide a mini-sanctuary for mammals, birds and insects alike.

Look out for red squirrels as well as signs of foxes and badgers.

Many species of birds are at home in the Chine, some friendly and some more shy. The streams and ponds are a haven for invertebrates, dragonflies and butterflies.

Plant Life

More than 150 varieties of wild plants exist within the Chine, and more than 50 species of moss and liverworts some extremely rare.

Ferns, grasses, wild garlic, horsetails, golden saxifrage, wild fuschia and heliotropes all grow in profusion.

Nature Hide
