## **Professional Storytellers**

Our professional storytellers choose tales to fit the situation, audience age and interests. Nursery and folk tales, urban myths and local legends, with stories ranging in length from ten minutes to half an hour.

We can offer a vast repertoire of tales, some true and some not-so-true but all of them engaging and entertaining.

There may be local legends of smugglers and shipwrecks interspersed with myths about why the sea is salty or why a crab has no head!

Older children use the framework of early years stories, nursery rhymes etc. to make their own narratives. They can be introduced to more complex stories, too, such as Greek myths, epic ballads and modern urban myths.

Stories can work on many levels - for sheer entertainment or to pass on cultural values, communicate morals, bind a community, inspire change or comfort troubled minds.

Storytelling at its best is a two-way process in which audience and storyteller work together.

Engaging and memorable, a good story will stay with the listener - it's like a message which has been passed to them. When written in the context of a story it is much easier to remember.
