A World Under the Waves

The Shipwreck Centre & Maritime Museum houses the largest exhibition of its kind in the UK.

Bursting with thousands of relics from shipwrecks and treasures from the deep, including beautiful "pieces of eight" Spanish gold, plus items salvaged from galleons, steam ships and wartime submarines.

See a fascinating display of antique diving equipment, Isle of Wight prehistory, dramatic shipwreck stories of pirates and smuggling, ship models and much more.

Free Activities

The museum offers a number of free activities for children during the visit-including a scavenger hunt, quiz and colouring pages.
