Oldest Working Water Mill

Set in 35 acres of stunning rural landscape, Calbourne Water Mill contains one of the oldest working water mills in the country, dating back to the Domesday Book.

Typical Visit

Start with an in-depth talk about the mill, adapted to the age group.

Watch a demonstration of milling using the water wheel, with a small packet of flour to take home.

Visit the World War and Victorian museums on site.

Look into the little rural museums, displaying a selection of memorabilia from a bygone age-Granma's Kitchen, Granfer's Shed, the Fire Station, Old Bakery and more.

Feed the geese, ducks, doves and peacocks with grain provided.

Enjoy straw bale building.

Visit the on-site renewable energy exhibit.

Walk the ancient woodlands looking

out for signs of badgers, red squirrels, foxes, birds and small mammals.

Buy a bag of fish food and feed the fish and eels in the mill stream.

Tour the on-site pottery and clay-play area and take home what you make.

Play at the lego tables and giant chalkboard.

Play adventure golf by the mill stream.
