Stunning Golden Beach

Shanklin Beach is one of the Isle of Wight's best known stretches of golden sands, which back onto a traditional English seafront promenade.

The beach is located on the south east coast of the Isle of Wight, with groynes keeping the sand in place and a high sea wall and pavement promenade between the sea and the esplanade.

Here you'll find all the traditional British seaside attractions you'd expect and more, with arcades, cafes, ice cream kiosks, restaurants and crazy golf.

Some parts of the beach are accessible at all states of the tide. There's also a wide sea wall ("revetment") running all the way to the next town of Sandown and even more attractions including their Victorian pier.

A cliff lift (chargeable) is a quick and easy way to get from the beach up into the town centre.
