What's Involved?

About this activity

This is a maths resource that engages students with their visit to the Isle of Wight Donkey Sanctuary. The resource task enables them to practise their data handling skills.

The activity will give students the opportunity to practise using real data in order to provide answers to problems related to their experience at the Sanctuary.

Students are asked to investigate the costs of keeping a donkey,

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complete calculations and present their data findings appropriately.

Questions & Answers

What is the task

The task requires the students to investigate the running costs of keeping a donkey and to calculate the impact of the donkey adoption scheme.

How does this link to my child's learning

- The task requires careful selection of relevant data, and the handling of such, in order to provide an answer to a problem.
- This is a key requirement in the National Curriculum

What will they learn?

Students will learn about how to select and record relevant data and then use it to answer a problem.

How does this enrich study undertaken in school?

- The stimulus of a real location that has been visited motivates the student in a more positive way.
- The problem becomes a real one, not purely a text book , dudi

What do they need to have done in preparation?

▶ Look at the costs of keeping a pet over a year, or similar activity.

What skills do they need to demonstrate?

- Careful selection of data and the ability to use it in order to solve problems
- ► Advanced Statistics & Data Mining (ASDM)
- Data handling
- ▶ Identifying appropriate operations to solve a problem
- Using percentages
